About our privacy policy

Internationaal Opel-Treffen cares a lot about your privacy. We therefore only process data that we need to (improve) our services and handle the information that we've collected about you and your use of our services carefully. We never put your data available for commercial purposes to third parties. This privacy policy applies to the use of this website and the service provided by International Opel-Treffen.

This privacy policy is valid from 25/05/2018, with the publication of this new version, the validity of all previous versions are expired.

This privacy policy describes what information about you is collected by us, where this data is used for and with whom and under what conditions this data can possibly be shared with third parties. We also explain to you how we store your data and how we protect your data against misuse and what rights you have with regard to the personal data you provide us. About the data processing

Below you can read how we process your data, where we save it, which security techniques we use and for whom the data are transparent.

Website software

Endless CMS

Our website has been developed with Endless software. Personal data that you make available to us for the benefit of our services will be shared with this party. Endless has access to you data to provide us (technical) support, they will never use your data for another purpose. Endless is obligated to take appropriate security measures based on the agreement we have made with them. These security measures consist of the application of SSL encryption and strong password policy. Endless uses cookies to collect technical information regarding your use of the software, no personal data is collected and/or stored. Endless reserves the right to share collected data within its own concern in order to further improve the service.

E-mail & mailing lists

Laposta

Our website uses Laposta, a third party that handles the e-mail traffic from our website and the sending of any newsletters. All confirmation e-mails that you receive from our website and web forms are sent via Laposta servers. Laposta will never use your name and e-mail address for its own purposes. At the bottom of every e-mail sent automatically via our website, you'll find the "unsubscribe" link. If you click here you will no longer receive e-mail from our website. This can seriously reduce the functionality of our website! Your personal data are stored securely by Laposta. Laposta uses cookies and other internet technologies that make it clear whether e-mails are opened and read. Laposta reserves the right to use your data for the further improvement of the service and share information with third parties.

Office365

We use the services of Office365 for our regular business e-mail traffic. This party has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to prevent abuse, loss and corruption of your and our data as much as possible. Office365 has no access to our mailbox and we handle all our e-mail traffic confidentially.

Payment processors

Sisow

We use the platform of Sisow to handle (a part of) the payments in our website. Sisow processes your name, address and residence details and your payment details such as bank account or credit card number. Sisow has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data. Sisow reserves the right to use your data to further improve the service and to share (anonymised) data with third parties. In the case of an application for a deferred payment (credit facility), Sisow will share personal information and information regarding your financial position with credit rating agencies. All the above-mentioned safeguards with regard to the protection of your personal data also apply to the parts of Sisow's services for which they engage third parties. Sisow will not retain your data for longer than is permitted by the legal terms.

PayPal

We use the platform of PayPal to handle (a part of) the payments in our website. PayPal processes your name, address and residence details and your payment details such as bank account or credit card number. PayPal has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data. PayPal reserves the right to use your data to further improve the service and to share (anonymised) data with third parties. In the case of an application for a deferred payment (credit facility), PayPal will share personal information and information regarding your financial position with credit rating agencies. All the above-mentioned safeguards with regard to the protection of your personal data also apply to the parts of PayPal's services for which they engage third parties. PayPal will not retain your data for longer than is permitted by the legal terms.

Purpose of data processing

General purpose of the processing

We only use your data for the benefit of our services. This means that the purpose of the processing is always directly related to the assignment you provide. We do not use your data for (targeted) marketing. If you share information with us and we use this information to contact you at a later time, other than at your request, we will ask you for explicit permission. Your information will not be shared with third parties, other than to comply with accounting and other administrative obligations. These third parties have all been kept confidential on the basis of the agreement between them and us or an oath or legal obligation.

Automatically collected data

Data that is automatically collected by our website is processed with the purpose of further improving our services. This information (for example your IP-address, web browser and operating system) is not considered personal data.

Participation in tasks and criminal investigation

In some cases, International Opel-Treffen may be obligated to share your data information in connection with government tax or criminal investigations on the basis of a legal obligation. In such case, we are forced to share your data, but we will oppose this within the possibilities that the law offers us.

Retention periods

We keep your data as long as you are our client. This means that we keep your customer profile until you indicate that you no longer wish to use our services. Based on applicable administrative obligations, we need to keep invoices with your (personal) data, so we will have this information for as long as the applicable term is in effect. However, employees no longer have access to your client profile and documents that we have produced in connection with your assignment.

Your rights

On the basis of the applicable Dutch and European legislation, you as the person involved, have certain rights with regard to the personal data that are processed by or on behalf of us. We explain below which rights these are and how you can invoke these rights.

In order to prevent abuse, we will send transcripts and copies of personal data, only to the e-mail address which is known in our database. In the event that you wish to receive the data to another e-mail address or for example per post, we kindly ask you to identify yourself. We keep records of the completed requests, in the case of a request to delete the data, we only administer anonymous data. You will receive all transcripts and copies of data in the machine readable data format that we use within our systems.

You have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority at all times when you suspect that we are using your personal information in the wrong way.

Right of inspection

You always have the right to inspect the data that we process or have processed that relate to your person or that can be traced back to you. You can submit a request to us for privacy matters. You will receive a response to your request within 30 days. If your request is granted, we will send you a copy of all data with an overview of the processors who have this data, with the e-mail address which is known with us, stating the category under which we have stored this data.

Rectification right

You always have the right to adjust the data that we process or have processed that relate to your person or that can be traced back to you. You can submit a request to us for privacy matters. You will receive a response to your request within 30 days. If your request is granted, we will send you the confirmation that the details have been changed on the e-mail address known to us.

Right to restriction of processing

You always have the right to limit the data that we process or have processed that relate to your person or that can be traced back to you. You can submit a request to us for privacy matters. You will receive a response to your request within 30 days. If your request is granted, we will send you the confirmation on the e-mail address known to us, that your data is no longer processed until you cancel the restriction.

Right of transferability

You always have the right to have the data that we process or have processed and that relate to your person or that can be traced back to you, performed by another party. You can submit a request to us for privacy matters. You will receive a response to your request within 30 days. If your request is

granted, we will send your transcripts and copies of all information about you that we have processed by us or by 3th parties, on the e-mail address known with us.

Right of objection and other rights

In such cases you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data by or on behalf of Internationaal Opel-Treffen. If you object, we will immediately stop the data processing pending the settlement of your objection. If your objection is well-founded, we will make transcripts and copies of data that we process available to you and then permanently discontinue the processing. You also have the right not to be subject to automated individual decision making or profiling. We do not process your data in such a way, that this right applies. If you are of the opinion that this is the case, please contact us for private matters.

Cookies

Google Analytics

Through our website, cookies are placed from the American company Google, as part of the "Analytics" service. We use this service to keep track of, and get reports on how our visitors use our website. This processor may be obliged to provide access to these data on the basis of applicable laws and regulations. We collect information about your browsing habits and share this information with Google. Google can interpret this information in conjunction with other datasets and thus track your movements on the internet. Google uses this information to provide, among other things, targeted advertisements (Adwords) and other Google services and products.
